

The NATO School ADL Office will support ADL training requests from the Regional Department of Defense Resources Management Studies on using the PfP LMS, and grants access to all ADL related trainings and workshops hosted and organized by the NATO School.

The NATO School ADL Office invites the Regional Department of Defense Resources Management Studies to participate in the in-person and online discussions about the further development of ADL courses.

NATO School authorizes DRESMARA to use the digital copy of NATO School Commandant signature on the Certificate of Completion for the ADL Course “Resource Management in NATO”.

3.2. Aims and Commitment of the Regional Department of Defense Resources Management Studies

Specific terms

The Regional Department of Defense Resources Management Studies will support the NATO School ADL Office and the NATO School mission by providing updated content for the “**Resource Management in NATO**” online course. The content should be in accordance with the vision of NATO, ACT and NATO Schools. The content for the ADL courses should be NATO Unclassified and releasable to NATO Partners and to the Internet.

As content provider, the Regional Department of Defense Resources Management Studies will regularly update ADL courses developed together with NATO School at least once a year or by Request of Course Director or Office of Primary Responsibility. The Regional Department of Defense Resources Management Studies will notify NATO School ADL Office immediately about any changes in the content of their courses to ensure updated and useful ADL content. The Course Director at the NATO School has to approve the updates or changes provided by the Regional Department of Defense Resources Management Studies.

The Regional Department of Defense Resources Management Studies will distribute the “**Resource Management in NATO**” online course, in close cooperation with NATO School ADL Office. DRESMARA will be able to distribute the course to its students and course members in fully accordance with its educational interests.

The progress made by all DRESMARA course participants will be monitored by DRESMARA staff, which will also make the final evaluation. Upon graduation, all participants who meet the final evaluation requirements will receive a “Certificate of Completion.” (Annex 1).

General terms

The ADL course developed together will be a contribution to the PfP Consortium ADL Community, represented by the ADL Working Group of the Partnership for Peace Consortium. The Regional Department of Defense Resources Management Studies can not withdraw the ADL course (without prior informing NATO School) from the Pfp LMS once the NATO School ADL Office or any of NATO School’s ADL partners are involved in the production.
